



Carpet Spotting Training Card

Cleaning Tasks:	<i>Split!</i>	Application Method
Attend to the spill as quickly as possible		
Remove furnishings and other items from the area to be cleaned.		
Remove gum and other items stuck to/in the carpet such as staples.		Putty Knife
If the spot or stain is already dry - vacuum the area to be cleaned.		B-Pack/Upright Vac.
Blot the spill into a clean microfiber cloth when possible.		Microfiber Cloth
To remove stains, dilute cleaner at 12oz per gallon in a spray bottle.	<i>Split! Carpet & Upholstery</i>	Pump Up/Qt. Sprayer
Spray lightly; rub lightly with a soft brush or:	<i>Split! Carpet & Upholstery</i>	Nylon Hand Brush
Use a microfiber towel in the direction of the center of the stain.	<i>Split! Carpet & Upholstery</i>	Microfiber Cloth
Blot with a clean terry or microfiber cloth, turning frequently.		Microfiber Cloth
Vacuum cleaned area when dry to remove any other loose split soil.		B-Pack/Upright Vac.
Vacuuming can be done the next day if you do not have time.

Display wet floor signs until carpet dries.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Back Pack or Upright 2-Motor Vacuum • Microfiber Cloths • Nylon Hand Brush 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Putty Knife • Tool to Remove Staples • <i>Split!</i> Carpet Cleaner <p>Extractors with a hose and upholstery tool can be used for effective spotting as a cold water extractor only. Use <i>Split!</i> for pre-spraying only.</p>



Upholstery Cleaning Training Card

Cleaning Tasks:	<i>Split!</i>	Application Method
Vacuum the area to be cleaned first with a backpack or cannister vacuum.		B-Pack/Upright Vacuum
Use spray bottle with diluted <i>Split!</i> at 12 oz. per gallon to pre-spray.	<i>Split! Carpet & Upholstery</i>	Pump up or Spray Bottle
Spray lightly and evenly, lightly scrub.	<i>Split! Carpet & Upholstery</i>	Nylon Brush
Then absorb with clean microfiber towels or:		Microfiber Towel
Fill your extractor with only with cold water.		Carpet/Up Extractor
Use spray bottle with diluted <i>Split!</i> at 12 oz. per gallon to pre-spray	<i>Split! Carpet & Upholstery</i>	Pump Up or Spray Bottle
Do not extend dwell time. Rub area with a microfiber cloth or a soft brush.		Microfiber or Brush
Immediately use the extractors hose and upholstery tool for extracting with cold water.		Extractor
Repeat if necessary. Avoid over wetting the upholstery.		
Vacuum cleaned area when dry to remove any other loose split soil.		B-Pack/Upright Vacuum.
Vacuuming can be done the next day if you do not have time.

Display wet floor signs until carpet dries.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Back Pack or 2-Motor Upright Vacuum • Carpet Extractor with hose and tool • Quart Spray Bottle and Sprayer or • Pump up sprayer • Microfiber Cloths 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Split!</i> Carpet and Upholstery Cleaner <p>Test cleaning area first by picking on a less visible spot on the upholstery just in case the fabric could potentially be damaged or discolored with cleaning. Natural fibers like wool and cotton based materials can potentially be problematic. Nylon and synthetic based products are less likely to be harmed.</p>
