



Carpet Cleaning



Remove furnishings and other items from the area to be cleaned.



Pick up large debris and loose paper on the floor. Remove gum and staples attached to the carpet.



Vacuum the carpet throughly using a professional vacuum such as a backpack vacuum or a dual motor upright vacuum cleaner.



Setup the **Camel** floor machine using **Split!** Carpet Cleaner at 12 oz. per gallon. If using another machine, fill pump-up sprayer at same dilution.



Wet bonnet on the bonnet brush with diluted *Split!* and install on machine.



Clean area by pre-spraying carpet with the **Camel** or pump-up then moving your machine over the pre-sprayed areas.



The cleaning operation can be repeated up to three times. Flip and exchange bonnets when needed.



Place the drying bonnet under the machine and go over cleaned area to dry extract carpet. Flip and exchange bonnet when needed.



Vacuum cleaned area when dry to remove any other loose split soil.



Vacuuming can be done the next day if you do not have time. Left over soil will remain on top of the carpet.



Split! Carpet and Upholstery Cleaner may be used with other low-moisture equipment, carpet extractors and bonnet systems.



For use in carpet extractors, dilute Split! at 3-4 oz per gallon of cold water in tank.
